## Blue Badge Microchip

Did you know you can get a microchip to attach to your blue badge from Cheshire West and Chester Council? It will allow you to use pay on exit car parks in Chester (except Delamere St) for up to four hours. You can apply online by searching for microchip Cheshire West, or just take your blue badge to your local council office Monday to Friday 9-12.30, and they will apply on your behalf to the parking department.
