“Hey Siri”

- Open your device Settings
- Tap Siri (or Apple Intelligence & Siri)
- Select Talk to Siri
- Choose "Siri" or "Hey Siri"
- Follow the on-screen prompts to train the phone to recognize your voice



“Hey Google”

- Open your device Settings
- Search for "Hey Google"
- Tap Voice Match
- Toggle the switch to turn it on
- Follow the on-screen prompts to train the assistant to recognise your voice

Voice assistants are hands-free, voice-activated tools built into your smartphone, letting you make calls, send messages, and search the web using just your voice.
